

AMVER AWARDS PROGRAM



The Amver Awards Program was inaugurated in 1971 to recognize those vessels which regularly participate in the Amver system.

Awards are given to vessels that send position reports and are available to divert a minimum of 128 days per year. The company receives a letter of appreciation while the ship receives a Certificate of Merit.

Special Amver awards are given for dramatic or exceptional rescues.
